Treasurers Report: Myrna wasn't at the meeting but submitted her report as follows; dues received was \$109.60, Disbursements \$74 in collections for Alzheimer's, Obligations \$403.00 and a balance of \$1335.38

Membership Report: Betty Robinson reported that she had called and sent letters to each of the members on the second dues list. President Collins reported that second dues notices were sent to Virginia Gill, Vic Humeniuk and Gary Wilder and that 7 members renewed this past month.
