Minutes of Meetings  
May 20, 2014

The Cookeville chapter of NARFE met May 20, at Shoney's Restaurant with 14 members and guests present. Meeting was opened by an invocation and pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Speaker was Michelle Parrott, Director of UT Extension Office in Putnam County.
